



Planned Parenthood Files Complaint with State Against Peter Kwon for Falsely Claiming Endorsement

Fain campaign: **"Voters deserve honesty, and that begins with trust and transparency from those seeking public office."**

South King County, WA — Planned Parenthood Alliance Advocates has filed a formal complaint with the Washington State Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) against King County Council candidate **Peter Kwon** for **falsely claiming their endorsement** in his campaign materials.

The official complaint, which can be read [here](#), criticizes Kwon for misleading voters by listing the organization's endorsement on his campaign materials, even after **Planned Parenthood Alliance Advocates rescinded their endorsement of him after discovering that he had lied about supporting their issues.**

"I've always been open about who I am and what I stand for," said **Steffanie Fain**, candidate for King County Council District 5. "As someone who has been a Planned Parenthood patient and a lifelong supporter of reproductive rights, I've spent my career expanding access to healthcare and standing up for the truth. Voters deserve leaders who are consistent and transparent about their values, especially on issues that impact people's lives and health."

During the Primary Election, Kwon was publicly listed as the **'Best Choice' by the King County Republican Party**, a designation that earned him significant conservative support. But after making it through the Primary, Kwon quietly had his name **removed from the GOP's website.**

Fain, a longtime South King County resident, working parent, and **President of the Harborview Medical Center Board of Trustees**, added, "Integrity and accountability aren't partisan issues. South King County deserves representatives who are transparent, accountable, and focused on delivering results. That's the approach I've brought to every role as an attorney, community volunteer, and Board President, from leading Harborview Medical Center's Board of Trustees to advocating for equitable access to care and services for everyone, regardless of income or background."

Fain emphasized that trust is the foundation of good governance. "Trust in government starts with honesty and I'm proud to have earned the confidence of so many neighbors and community members throughout District 5."

Steffanie is the only candidate endorsed by over 115 community leaders, elected officials, the King County Democrats, labor unions, small business organizations, firefighters, and first responders across South King County.

The campaign urged voters to review the complaint and stay informed.
